**Recycling Week:** Collected same day as trash, keep 10' apart

**Earth Day Festival:** 10 am-4 pm, Rain or Shine, 6700 Delilah Rd., EHT. Check [acua.com/earthday](http://acua.com/earthday) for details!

**Bulky Waste:** Collected by Public Works the 1st full week of each month

**Brush/Yard Waste:** Public Works collects the 2nd full week of the month

**Food Drive (Dec. 11-15):** Place food donation next to your recycling.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE Drop-off Days:** 8 am - 1 pm  
6700 Delilah Road, EHT 08234. Proof of residency required.  
Containers will *not* be returned. [acua.com/hhw](http://acua.com/hhw)

ACUA will no longer empty drums and barrels of any size.  
Full container weight limit is 50 lbs. (excluding wheeled/lidded carts)

## DISPOSAL INFORMATION

**Electronics:** The Town of Hammonton collects electronics from *residents only* along with bulky waste items. <http://www.townofhammonton.org/electronic-waste-disposal>. ACUA does not accept electronics.

**Latex Paint:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. [acua.com/paint](http://acua.com/paint)

**Batteries:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium, silver-oxide and lead-acid batteries should be taken to our Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Days. [acua.com/hhw](http://acua.com/hhw)

**Shredded Paper:** Cannot be recycled curbside, but can be brought to ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. [acua.com/rcdropoffs](http://acua.com/rcdropoffs)
